

How to fold a Chinese Prefold Diaper Basic Fold



1. Lay the diaper flat lengthwise in front of you



2. Bring the two sides of the diaper in towards the center folding into thirds.



3. Fan out the top of the diaper to fit inside of a diaper cover or to use when pinning or using a snappi fastener.

This is the most basic of folds and from this point the diaper can be laid in a cover, pinned or fastened with a Snappi Fastener.

How to fold a Chinese Prefold Diaper for use with a Velcro or Snap Cover



1. Lay the diaper flat lengthwise in front of you



2. Fold the bottom of the diaper up towards the center. Adjusting the length to fit your baby and/or her diaper cover.



3. Fold one side of the diaper in towards the center as shown above.



4. Fold in the remaining side and tuck in to the previously folded side to help keep it in place.



5. Lay the diaper in your diaper wrap and fasten.

How to fold a Chinese Prefold Diaper to Use with Pins or a Snappi Fastener



1. Lay the diaper flat lengthwise in front of you



2. Fold the bottom of the diaper up towards the center. Adjusting the length to fit your baby and/or her diaper cover.



3. Fold one side of the diaper in towards the center as shown above.



4. Fold in the remaining side and tuck in to the previously folded side to help keep it in place.



5. Fold the diaper up between babies legs.



6. Pin the diaper on each side or use a Snappi Fastener.

How to fold a Chinese Prefold Diaper using the Bikini / Twist Method



1. Lay the diaper flat lengthwise in front of you



2. Turn the bottom of the diaper over twisting once in the center.



3. Bring the diaper up between babies legs and fasten on each side using diaper pins or a Snappi Fastener.

How to fold a LARGE Chinese Prefold Diaper for use with a small Velcro or Snap Cover



1. Lay the diaper flat horizontally in front of you 2. Fold in the sides.

3. You will have a flat rectangle that is much shorter than if you had used it length wise.



Lay the large diaper that has been folded in thirds into the small diaper cover as shown. You may want to fan out the back of the diaper.

How to fold a Terry No-Fold for use with a Velcro or Snap Cover



1. Open the cover and lay the Terry No-fold on top of it. The Terry No-fold may look too large for the cover. Don't worry having a baby inside will make a big difference. :)



2. Lay your baby on top of the diaper and cover and bring the diaper up between babies legs. Adjust the length of the diaper by folding over at the waist if necessary.

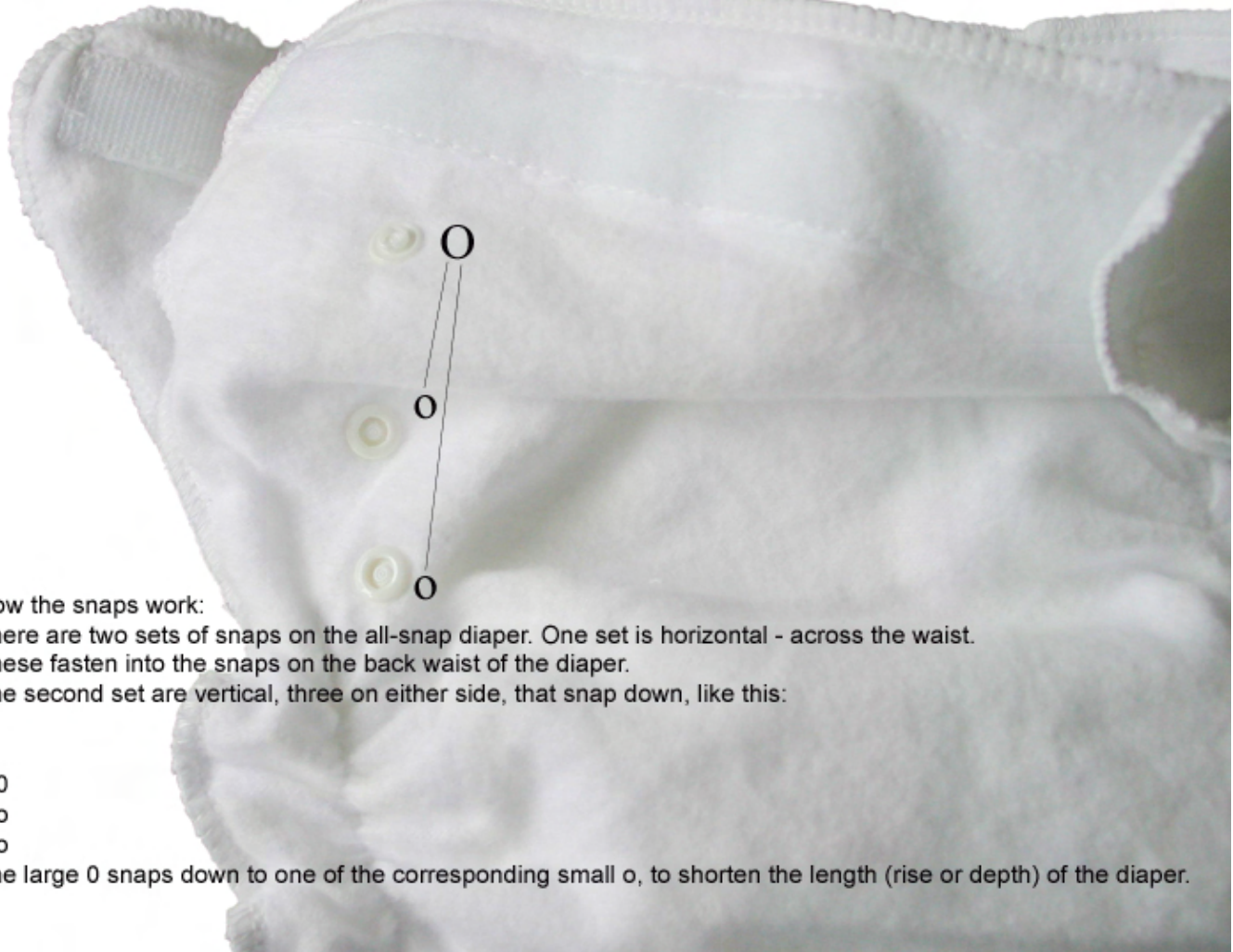


3. Bring the diaper cover up between babies legs and over the diaper and fasten using the velcro tabs or snaps depending on the cover you are using.



4. Once snugly fastened make sure all of the diaper is inside the cover.

Snugtofit Snap Diaper will have snaps at the waist. ... this photo shows a velcro waist.



How the snaps work:

There are two sets of snaps on the all-snap diaper. One set is horizontal - across the waist.

These fasten into the snaps on the back waist of the diaper.

The second set are vertical, three on either side, that snap down, like this:

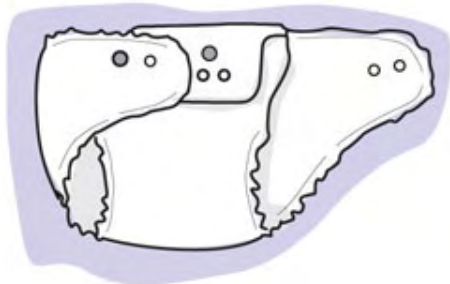

The large O snaps down to one of the corresponding small o, to shorten the length (rise or depth) of the diaper.

Smallest size setting



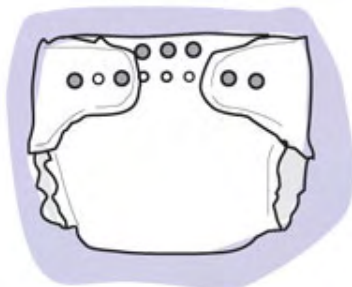
Smallest size fully closed
