



Washing Cloth Diapers and Covers

The Baby Marketplace Inc. cloth diapers and diaper covers are made from the highest quality fabrics available. Proper care for these will assure long use and comfortable wear for baby.

Please wash diapers before first use. Remember that if you are unsure if the size is correct, only wash and shrink one diaper, as we cannot accept returns on washed (or used) diapers.

The diapers will shrink most after the first wash and dry, but continue to shrink slightly for a few more washings.

Do not use fabric softener when washing or drying the diapers. Fabric softener works by leaving a coating on the fabric, and this will reduce the absorbency of the cotton. There is also risk of skin irritation for baby, once this gets wet.

Regular cleaning detergents (like Tide, Purex, Gain...) are very good at getting the diapers clean and germ free. You do not need to purchase any special cleaning products, unless you really want to!

You do not need to use hot water to wash. Most of these detergents are formulated for effective cleaning and sanitizing without hot water.

An extra rinse is a good idea, especially since most people use too much detergent on their diapers!

Stain Prevention: Rinse any of the diapers that have been soiled in COLD water. Hot water will set stains.

Do not use chlorine bleach. Use of this will accelerate the deterioration of all the fabrics and components of these diaper products. You will shorten the lifespan of the product considerably.

The diapers and diaper covers (Don't put the Bummi's Whisper Pants or Printed Wraps in the Dryer) can go in the dryer or be hung to dry.

A copy of these laundering instructions will be included with all diaper orders.

Many diapers and covers come with specific washing instructions. Please refer to the manufacturers specific specifications.
